All of the RSUs shall vest 100% with respect to the total number of RSUs on the third anniversary of the Grant Date; and upon any termination of employment, any units that have not vested shall be forfeited to the Corporation.

(4) Shares held in account under the NIKE, Inc. 401(k) and Profit Sharing Plan.

(5) John F. Slusher, Trustee of Jennifer Nadia Slusher Trust

(6) Stock Option granted on 07/20/2017 and becomes exercisable with respect to 25% of the shares on each of the first four anniversaries of the date of the grant.
