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Item 3.02 Unregistered Sales of Equity Securities

On January 23, 2006, Stifel Financial Corp. (Stifel) closed a private placement offering of 1,052,220 shares of its common stock at a purchase price of \$25.00 per share. The shares are being offered to accredited investors pursuant to Rule 506 of regulation D of the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the Securities Act). The investors are capital markets personnel of the Legg Mason Wood Walker Inc. capital markets business acquired by Stifel (the Acquisition) as reported on the current report on Form 8-K of Stifel filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on September 12, 2005.

The investors executed subscription agreements and acknowledged, among other things, that the securities to be issued were not registered under the Securities Act, that the investors understood the economic risk of an investment in the purchase of the shares and that the investors had the opportunity to ask questions and receive answers from Stifel concerning the terms and conditions of the offering. Net proceeds from the sale of the common stock are expected to be used to increase Stifel sequity capital required to support the combined capital markets business following completion of the Acquisition and for general corporate purposes including future acquisitions.
