NOTICE OF STOCKHOLDER ACTION BY WRITTEN CONSENT

GENERAL INFORMATION

To the Holders of Common Stock of Brazil Minerals, Inc.:

This Information Statement has been filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission and is being furnished, pursuant to Section 14C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Exchange Act"), to the holders (the "Stockholders") of common stock, par value \$0.001 per share (the "Common Stock"), of Brazil Minerals, Inc., a Nevada corporation (the "Company"), to notify the Stockholders that on February 20, 2015, the Company received approval from the Board of Directors of the Company (the "Board") and a written consent in lieu of a meeting (the "Written Consent") from a certain holder (the "Majority Stockholder") of Series A Preferred Stock, par value \$0.001 per share ("Preferred Stock"). The Majority Stockholder beneficially owns one share of Preferred Stock, which has 51% of the voting power with respect to the approval by stockholders of an amendment to the Company's Articles of Incorporation to increase the number of authorized shares of Common Stock from six hundred million (600,000,000) to two billion (2,000,000,000) (the "Authorized Increase").

On February 20, 2015, the Board approved this action and recommended to the Majority Stockholder that he approve them. On February 20, 2015, the Majority Stockholder approved the Authorized Increase by written consent in lieu of a meeting in accordance with the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"). Accordingly, your consent is not required and is not being solicited in connection with the approval of these Authorized Increase.

We will mail the Notice of Stockholder Action by Written Consent to the Stockholders on or about March 5, 2015.

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## INTRODUCTION

Section 78.320 of the NRS provides that the written consent of the holders of outstanding shares of voting capital stock having not less than the minimum number of votes which would be necessary to authorize or take such action at a meeting at which all shares entitled to vote thereon were present and voted can approve an action in lieu of conducting a special stockholders' meeting convened for the specific purpose of such action. The NRS, however, requires that in the event an action is approved by written consent, a company must provide prompt notice of the taking of any corporate action without a meeting to the stockholders of record who have not consented in writing to such action and who, if the action had been taken at a meeting, would have been entitled to notice of the meeting if the record date for such meeting had been the date that written consents signed by a sufficient number of holders to take the action were delivered to the company.

In accordance with the foregoing, we will mail the Notice of Stockholder Action by Written Consent on or about March 5, 2015. This Information Statement contains a brief summary of the material aspects of the Authorized Increase approved by the Board of Brazil Minerals, Inc. (the "Company," "we," "our," or "us ") and the Majority Stockholder which holds a majority of the voting capital stock of the Company.

Voting Stock

As of March 4, 2015, there were issued and outstanding 267,757,476 shares of Common Stock and one share of Preferred Stock. The one share of Preferred Stock entitles the holder to 51% of the total voting power on all matters. Pursuant to Section 78.320 of the NRS, at least a majority of the voting equity of the Company is required to approve the Authorized Increase by written consent. The Majority Stockholder has voted his one share of Preferred Stock in favor of the Authorized Increase, thereby satisfying the requirement under Section 78.320 of the NRS that at least a majority of the voting equity vote in favor of a corporate action by written consent.

The following table sets forth the name of the Majority Stockholder, the number of shares of Common Stock and Preferred Stock held and voted by the Majority Stockholder in favor of the Authorized Increase, and the percentage of the issued and outstanding voting equity of the Company voted in favor thereof.

#### ACTION TO BE TAKEN

The Authorized Increase will become effective on the date that we file a Certificate of Amendment to the Company's Articles of Incorporation, as amended (the "Amendment"), with the State of Nevada. We intend to file the Amendment with the State of Nevada promptly after the twentieth (20<sup>th</sup>) day following the date on which this Information Statement is mailed to the Stockholders.

#### INCREASE IN AUTHORIZED SHARES OF COMMON STOCK

The number of authorized shares of our Common Stock will be increased from six hundred million (600,000,000) shares to two billion (2,000,000,000) shares. The Board of Directors believes that the Authorized Increase is necessary and advisable in order to maintain our financing and capital raising ability and for the Company to have enough authorized shares of common stock to enable the holders of our outstanding convertible debt to convert all of such debt into common stock.

As of March 4, 2015, approximately one-third of the increase in the authorized shares of common stock, will be to be pledged as additional collateral to persons who have paid the Company an aggregate of one million dollars for future delivery of GIA-graded polished diamonds, as the transaction documents with such persons provide that the amount of collateral shall be subject to adjustment depending on the amount of diamonds which have been delivered and the market price of our common stock. The earliest time that any such shares placed as collateral will not be returnable to the Company is December 31, 2016, which is the deadline for delivery of the GIA-graded diamonds.

In addition, the second largest part of the newly authorized shares will be used to increase the amount of common stock which will be reserved for issuance upon conversion of outstanding convertible debt of the Company. The transaction documents generally require the Company to reserve between 3 to 5 times the number of shares needed for full conversion of the debt at any given point in time. Due to recent decreases in the market price of the Company's common stock the number of shares of common stock which must be reserved pursuant to such contractual arrangements must be increased. Upon full satisfaction of the debt (by payment or conversion into common stock) the reserves shall be cancelled.

The Authorized Increase will not have any immediate effect on the rights of existing stockholders, but may have a dilutive effect our existing stockholders if additional shares are issued.

We are not increasing our authorized shares of Common Stock to construct or enable any anti-takeover defense or mechanism on behalf of the Company or for any planned merger or acquisition.

As of March 4, 2015, there were a total of 267,757,476 shares of Common Stock issued and outstanding and one share of Preferred Stock issued and outstanding.

Under those rules, beneficial ownership includes any shares as to which a person or entity has sole or shared voting power or investment power plus any shares which such person or entity has the right to acquire within sixty (60) days of March 4, 2015, through the exercise or conversion of any stock option, convertible security, warrant or other right. Unless otherwise indicated, each person or entity named in the table has sole voting power and investment power (or shares such power with that person's spouse) with respect to all shares of capital stock listed as owned by that person or entity, and the address of each of the stockholders listed below is: c/o Brazil Minerals, Inc. 155 North Lake Avenue, Suite 800, Pasadena, California 91101. The Certificate of Designations, Preferences and Rights of our Preferred Stock provides that for so long as the Preferred Stock is issued and outstanding, the holders of Preferred Stock shall vote together as a single class with the holders of our Common Stock, with the holders of Preferred Stock being entitled to 51% of the total votes on all matters regardless of the actual number of shares of Preferred Stock then outstanding, and the holders of Common Stock being entitled to their proportional share of the remaining 49% of the total votes based on their respective voting power.
