According to information received from BES, as of 30 June 2011, the voting rights attached to 90,274,180 PT shares, representing 10.07% of PT's share capital and corresponding voting rights, were attributable to BES as follows:

- BES: 4,218 PT shares;
- Companies in a control or group relationship with BES: 90,214,747 PT shares;
- Members of BES corporate bodies: 55,451 PT shares.
