  - On March 20, 2002, the reporting person entered into a variable prepaid forward arrangement ("VPF") with an unaffiliated third party buyer (the "Buyer") pursuant to which the reporting person received a cash payment of \$624,876.72. In exchange for the cash payment, the reporting person pledged 50,000 shares of common stock of O'Reilly Automotive, Inc. (the "Company") and agreed to settle the VPF
- (1) with either a payment of cash or the delivery of up to 50,000 shares of the Company's common stock. The reporting person chose to settle the VPF through the delivery of shares. The number of shares delivered by the reporting person to the Buyer at settlement was based upon the price of the Company's common stock on each of the 5 business days (each an "Averaging Date") prior to and including April 9, 2007 (each a "Settlement Price"), as follows: (continued in Footnote 2)
- (2) (continued from Footnote 2) (i) if the Settlement Price were less than or equal to \$14.07 per share, then the reporting person would be required to deliver 10,000 shares, per day (which represents the total number of shares subject to the VPF divided by the number of Averaging Dates) to the Buyer; (ii) if the Settlement Price had been greater than \$14.07 but less than \$18.30 per share, then the reporting person would be required to deliver a number of shares equal to the product of 10,000 times \$14.07, divided by the Settlement Price; and

- (continued from Footnote 3) (iii) if the Settlement Price were greater than \$18.30, then the reporting person would be required to deliver a number of shares equal to 10,000 multiplied by a fraction, the numerator of which would be the sum of \$14.07 plus the difference
- (3) between the Settlement Price and \$18.30, and the denominator of which would be the Settlement Price. The Settlement Price on each Averaging Date ranged from a high of \$33.65 and a low of \$32.83, resulting in the reporting person delivering a total of 48,726 shares of the Company's common stock to the Buyer.
