On September 25, 2006, Peterson & Company, LLP ("Peterson") resigned as the Company's independent auditors.

During the fiscal year ended December 31, 2005, and the subsequent interim period through the date of the resignation of Peterson, there have been no disagreements on any matter of accounting principles or practices, financial statement disclosure or auditing scope or procedure, which disagreements, if not resolved to the satisfaction of Peterson, would have caused it to make reference to the subject matter of the disagreements in connection with its report. During the fiscal year ended December 31, 2005 and through the date of resignation, there have been no "reportable events" (as that term is defined in Regulation S-B Item 304(a) (1) (v)).

The report of Peterson on the financial statements of the Company for the year ended December 31, 2005 did not contain an adverse opinion or a disclaimer of opinion and was not qualified or modified as to uncertainty, audit scope or accounting principles, except that the report for the year ended December 31, 2005 stated that our accumulated losses and lack of working capital raised substantial doubt about our ability to continue as a going concern.

The Company provided Squar, Milner, Peterson, Miranda & Williamson, LLP ("Squar Milner"), successor to Peterson, with a copy of the foregoing disclosures. Attached as Exhibit 16 is a copy of Squar Milner's letter, dated March 5, 2007, stating its agreement with such statements.
